

The ERC supports excellence in frontier research in all disciplines through a bottom-up, individual-based competition



- Scientific governance: independent Scientific Council with 22 members including the ERC President; full authority over funding strategy
- Support by the ERC Executive Agency (autonomous)
- ~ 500 members of staff

Evaluation

- ~ 1000 panel members in 75 panels
- ≻~ 6000 remote referees
- ≻~1500 interviews for young applicants

track-record of significant research achievements in the last 10 years up to € 2.5+1 M for 5 years

Proof-of-Concept Grants

bridging gap between research - earliest stage of marketable innovation up to €150,000 for ERC grant holders Synergy Grants 2-4 Pls for 6 years up to € 10+4 M for 6 years







- Established in 2021, based on the Joint Declaration of the Charles University and the Czech Academy of Sciences, with the support of the Technology Centre of CAS, and open to all research institutions in the Czech Republic
- A Coordinator plus 6 members representing the three ERC domains ERC (LS, PE, SSH)
- Systematic support for ERC applicants on the national level.
- Complemented by local initiatives of individual research organizations.



ERC Mentorship Initiative – since 2021

- The initiative supports local offices in the member states that organize, region/nation-wide, hands-on sessions for preselected applicants where the applicants get expert scientific feedback on their proposal (or mock interviews) before submission.

- ERC will provide annually a list of ERC grantees and former panel members who would be potentially keen to serve as external mentors helping the specific local office.

- The Czech National Support Team joined the ERC Mentorship Initiative.
