Suggestions regarding the evaluation of final reports of IGC student scientific projects

The project cannot be evaluated as fulfilled if the promised publication outputs have not been yet achieved and are not entered in the database of publications of VŠE. If the outputs have been sent for review in accordance with the plan, the project is assessed as fulfilled with reservation to publication outputs.

A. Achieving project objectives

- a) Have the project objectives been achieved?
- b) Is the implementation of the project sufficiently scientifically justifiable (especially the correct use of methods)?
- c) Does the implementation of the project show elements of innovation?
- d) Has there been progress in the state of knowledge and contribution to the development of theory in the relevant field?

B. Publication activity

- a) Have the project outputs already been published or submitted for peer-review in the number corresponding to the originally anticipated number and quality of target journals in the grant application?
- b) Have the obligations been fulfilled as regards the publication of outputs??
- c) Is it realistic to achieve publication outputs at least at the same or higher quality level than originally anticipated in the grant application?

C. Usability of the research results

- a) Are the project results socially relevant, usable in practice?
- b) Can further research at VSE suitably built on the project results, in particular externally funded research?

D. Management with allocated funds

a) Has the budget structure been respected or, if there have been any transfers of appropriations in budget, are these transfers duly justified?
